- If for any reason a crop is cancelled, registrants are notified by email and issued a credit.

# Bulky Item Pick-Ups

Starting in 2025, Sparkle & Shine has been discontinued.

In its place, residents needing to dispose of large bulky items such as appliances, chairs, couches, etc. can contact Waste Management either by phone or through their customer web portal.

Waste Management will provide bulky waste pickup to all residential cart-based service recipients up to six (6) times each calendar year, one (1) item per collection, at no additional charge.

Additional item pick-ups are subject to an additional fee, as set forth below. Bulky waste items must be properly prepared and placed at the curb by 6:00 a.m., on the agreed upon collection day.

## APPLIANCES \$10/per item

- REFRIGERATORS
