



# Residential Waste and Recycling Franchise Agreement

## PROGRAM INFORMATION

### When does the agreement begin and end?

The franchise agreement is exclusive with Advanced Disposal. It will commence on January 1, 2020 and shall expire on December 31, 2024. The Village shall have the right to extend the agreement for (2) additional years upon receipt of a written proposal by Advanced Disposal at least 180 days prior to the expiration date of the then current term. **Due to the New Year's Day Holiday, the first pick-up date is Friday, January 3rd.**

### Monthly Collection and Disposal Fees

\*Advanced Disposal will bill quarterly, in advance for collection and disposal services.

### Collection Schedule Thursdays

Waste—Once Weekly  
Recycling—Once Weekly  
Yard waste—Once Weekly (seasonal)

### Collection Location and Day

Waste, recycling and yard waste will be collected curbside once weekly on Thursdays. Garbage and recycling carts should be placed at the curb facing the street for pick-up. Yard waste should be in bags or bundles neatly stacked at the curb.

Holiday weeks will push pick-up to Friday for all services. Observed holidays are New Year's Day, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day & Christmas Day.

### How to start my service?

Advanced Disposal will automatically deliver a 95 gallon garbage cart to all residents that do not currently have service with Advanced Disposal by December 28th. All residents will be provided with an Advanced Disposal cart by January 15th.

Recycling is not mandatory, but encouraged. If you would like a 65 gallon recycling cart please contact Advanced Disposal at (217) 963-2788.

**NOTE: Only waste at the curb in a cart provided by Advanced Disposal will be picked-up. Residents will not be allowed to use any other type of garbage can or place bags at the curb.**

### Can I Opt-Out?

All single family dwellings are required to have waste services but may opt out of recycling.

### Exceptions for Waste Disposal

Commercial businesses and multi-family buildings are required to have dumpster service with a Mt. Zion licensed commercial waste hauler.

Vacant properties are not required to subscribe to waste and/or recycling services. Once the property is occupied, the new owner or tenant will be required to obtain residential waste disposal services.

### Carts and Additional Waste

Each single-family dwelling shall be provided a 95 gallon cart for waste and an additional cart for recyclables, both **FREE** of charge. Additional carts can be rented for \$3.50/month.

### Snowbirds

Residents who move to warmer locations during the winter months can elect to suspend services for a minimum of 30 days and a maximum of 180 days upon 7 days notice to Advanced Disposal.
